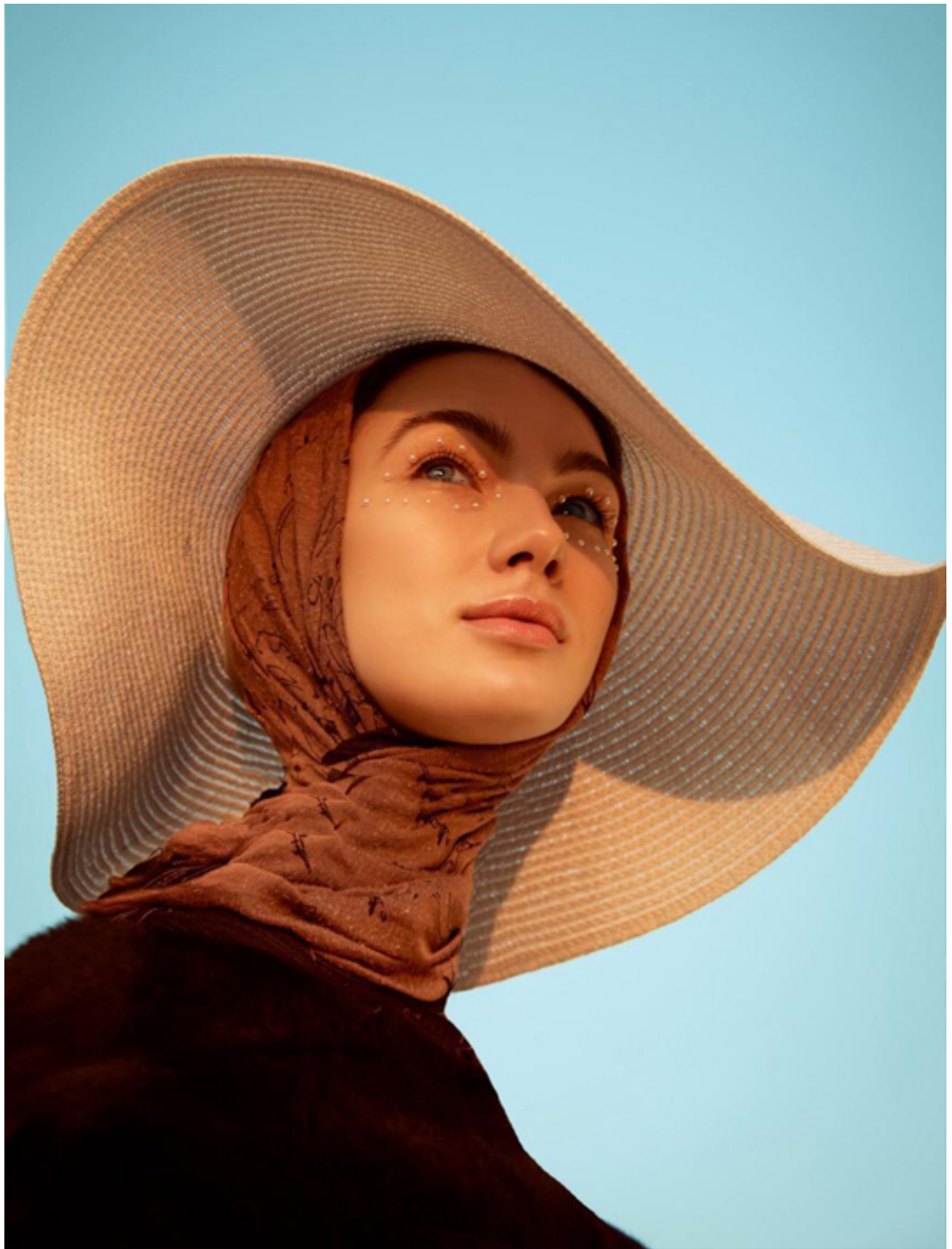


















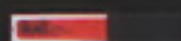


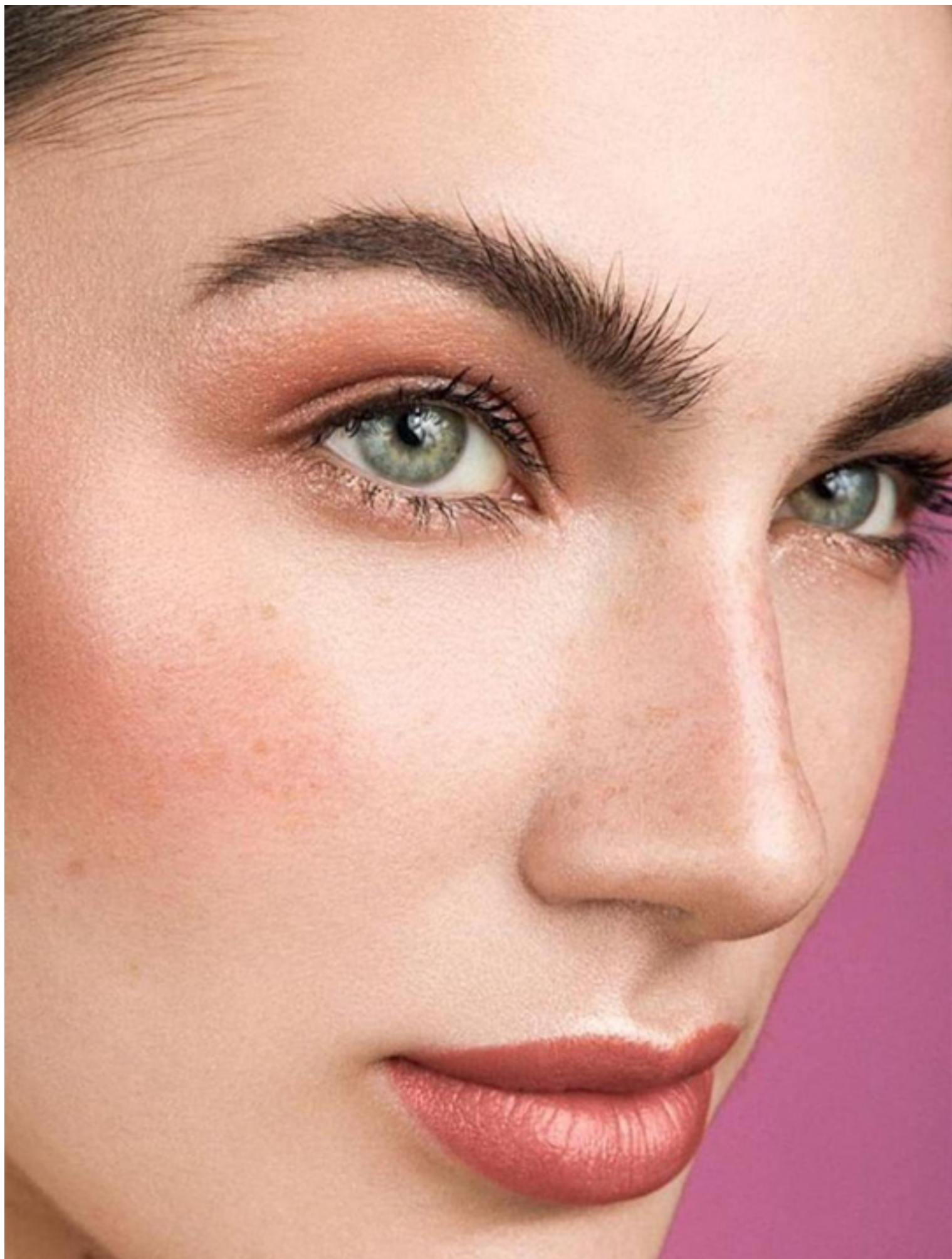


BURST OF ORANGE

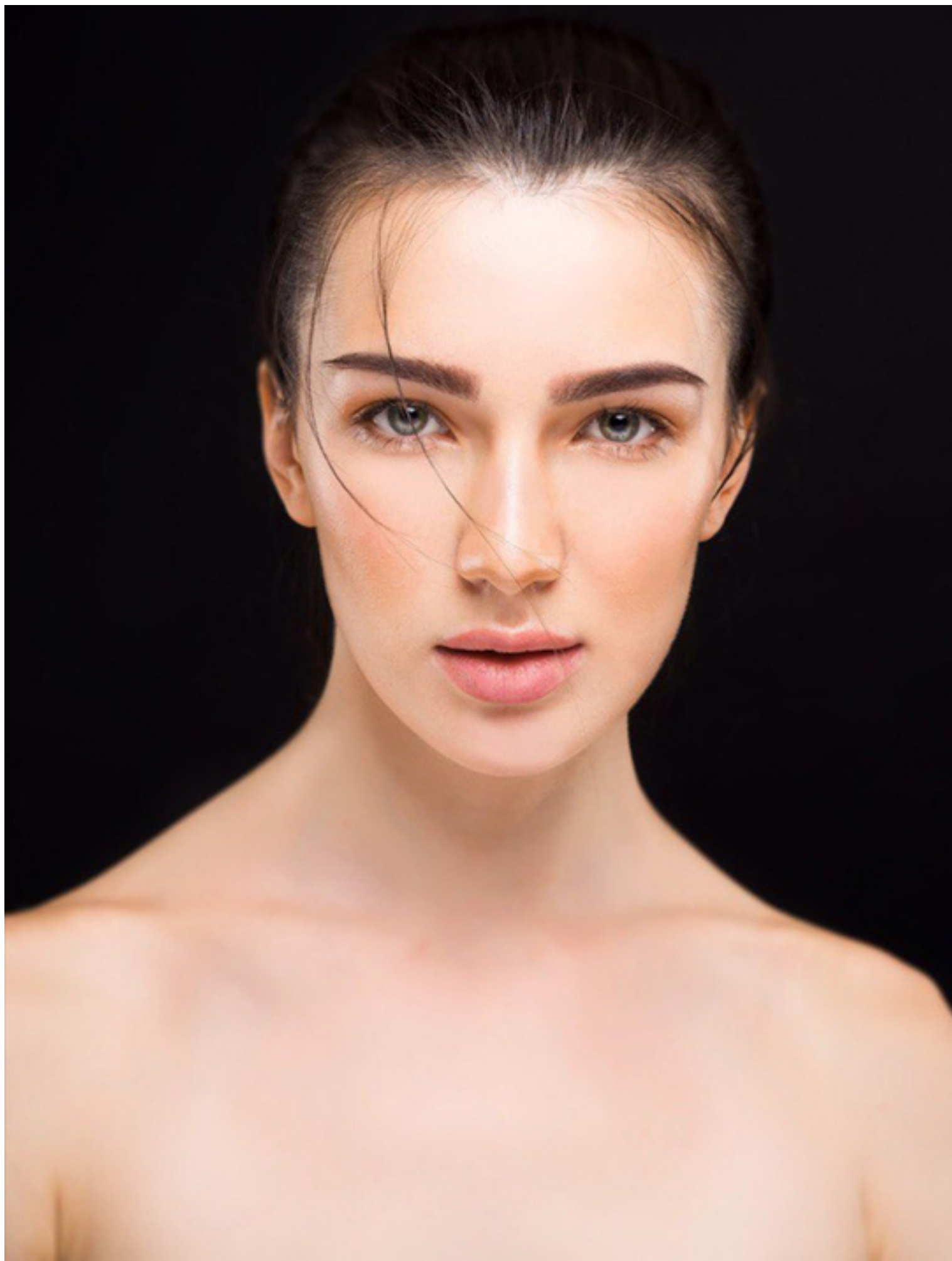
BLUES CLUES
